| Parameters       | Accepted Values | Description  | Default | Since |
|------------------|-----------------|--|---------|-------|
| (body of plugin) |                 | Instructions::Feedback                             |         |       |
| <b>trackerId</b> |                 | Numeric value representing the miniquiz tracker ID |         | 1     |

The tracker must have the following fields:

| Field           | Type           | Purpose  |
|-----------------|----------------|--|
| <i>question</i> | text field     | the question   |
| <i>answer</i>   | text field     | correct answer   |
| <i>option a</i> | text field     | false answer   |
| <i>option b</i> | text field     | false answer   |
| <i>option c</i> | text field     | false answer   |
| <i>valid</i>    | checkbox field | indicates that the tracker item is to be used as a quiz item |
