# Google Maps Admin

[Google Map](#) feature can be enabled through "**Admin home > Features > Google Map**".

It can be initially set up for the whole Tiki through "**Admin home > Google Maps**" ([tiki-admin.php?page=gmap](#)).

First time, it will recognize that you don't have any Google Map key for your specific web site domain (required), and it will suggest you to request one at:

Once you complete the process in the Google site side, you can come copy the generated key to the corresponding field in **tiki-admin.php?page=gmap**. Once done, you will be able to see your map below, like this:
