

Minify CSS

Starting in [Tiki19](#): Make the filenames of minified CSS files be based on the contents of all the files, not just the filenames, so that when anything changes within a file, i.e. after an upgrade or bug fix, browsers will automatically get the new version of the code (following clearing the tiki caches only). This had already been done for JavaScript in [Tiki18](#)

New in the [performance](#) admin panel in [Tiki5](#), you can activate to aggregate and compress all CSS files in one. In some tests, this has permitted to generate a huge point increase when testing with [Yahoo! YSlow](#)
