

## Number Styles

Tiki has support for styling numbers in different formats. Many of the CSS attribute `list-style-type` values are supported along with a few that are specific to Tiki. At the time of writing, it is only safe to use positive whole numbers, although some may work with zero or negative values.

If `disc`, `circle`, `square` or `none` are used, the number will be ignored and the selection will be displayed instead. `None` may allow some features to be disabled.

The supported values are as follows:

- `decimal-leading-zero`
- `lower-alpha`
- `upper-alpha`
- `lower-greek`
- `upper-greek`
- `lower-roman`
- `upper-roman`
- `hebrew`
- `georgian`
- `footnote`
- `disc`
- `circle`
- `square`
- `none`
