<code>initial</code>		Initial page to show		2.0

<code>categId</code>	Valid category ID or list separated by :, + or -	<p>Filter categories by Id numbers. Use different separators to filter as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><code>:</code> - Page is in any of the specified categories. Example: <code>1:2:3</code></li> <li><code>+</code> - Page must be in all of the specified categories. Example: <code>1+2+3</code></li> <li><code>-</code> - Page is in the first specified category and not in any of the others. Example: <code>1-2-3</code></li> </ul>	2.0
