

# Modifiez vos pagesÂ Wiki

Cette page est un tutoriel.

Si vous avez les permissions appropriÃ©es (d'habitude, il ne s'agit que d'Ãªtre inscrite/inscrit) vous verrez le menu au bas ou au haut de cette page avec plusieurs options et une d'elle c'est l'option: **edit** , quand vous cliquez **edit** cela veut dire que vous pouvez modifier cette page et vous pouvez Ã©crire du texte sur celle-ci. Utilisez la fonctionnalitÃ©

**preview** autant de fois que vous le dÃ©sirez et donc au besoin. Puis une fois terminÃ©, cliquez sur **save** .

Pour crÃ©er un nouveau Wiki, vous devez d'abord gÃ©nÃ©rer une rÃ©fÃ©rence vers la nouvelle page Ã  partir d'une page existante. Le Wiki gÃ©nÃ“re automatiquement une rÃ©fÃ©rence si vous Ã©crivez un mot constituÃ© par la concatÃ©nation de plusieurs mots commenÃ§ant par des majuscules, comme par exemple

)ThisIsMyPageouTennisResultsouVisitLondon(. Quand cette rÃ©fÃ©rence est utilisÃ©e pour la premiÃ“re fois dans la page, le nom de la rÃ©fÃ©rence sera affichÃ© suivi d'un point d'interrogation. Vous pouvez Ã©galement placer plusieurs mots entre des doubles parenthÃ“ses pour crÃ©er un lien : ((Ma PremiÃ“re Page)). Etudions un exemple.

Nous allons Ã©diter la page d'accueil.

Access the home page and click **edit** at the top (or bottom) of the page.



The number of options and boxes when editing a page depends on the features enabled when configuring the Wiki. Write some text making sure you use the word ))MyFirstPage(), save the page using **save** . Use the **preview** button if you want to preview how the page will look like once edited.

As you can see there's a "?" question mark following ))MyFirstPage, this indicates that MyFirstPage() is referenced from this page but has no content (it was never edited) so the "?" question mark is a link to edit this page. Click the question mark to edit this new page.

Edit this new page and save it using the save button  
Click the **home** option in the menu (left pane) to return to the ))HomePage().

As you can see ))MyFirstPage is now displayed as a link, if you click on it you will access MyFirstPage() viewing the content you just edited.

This is how new pages are created and edited and how the Wiki is navigated, as you can see creating pages is really easy and that's why Wiki's are populated at a very high speed rate by their users adding pages and content as they need.
