

# Module top\_pages

This module displays the top wiki pages, ranked by page views, and provides a link to each page.

# Parameters

Displays the specified number of wiki pages with links to them, starting with the one having the most hits.

# Usage

You will see it listed at "Admin > Modules > Assign new module > Module Name (drop down)" (**tiki-admin\_modules.php**).

You can assign this Module to a column (See Module Admin page if needed) or other module zone, or you can include within a wiki page, using the PluginModule.

# Wiki Syntax

Valid options for displaying the "Top Pages" module using the PluginModule are:

## Full block-style wiki-plugin syntax

```
{MODULE(module=>"top_pages")}{MODULE} {MODULE(module=>top_pages)}{MODULE}  
{MODULE(module="top_pages")}{MODULE} {MODULE(module=top_pages)}{MODULE}
```

## Shortened syntax

```
{MODULE(module=>top_pages) /} {MODULE(module="top_pages") /} {MODULE(module=top_pages) /}
```

## Minimal syntax

```
{module module="top_pages"} {module module=top_pages}  
See PluginModule for additional parameters that can be used.
```

# Examples

Using this code

```
{MODULE(module=>top_pages, max=>5) /}
```
