

# Plugin BigBlueButton

Use this wiki plugin, introduced in Tiki5, to invoke a BigBlueButton in a page.

# Parameters

Hold a video/audio/chat/presentation session using the BigBlueButton web conferencing system.

*Introduced in Tiki 5. Required parameters are in **bold**.*

*Preferences required:* `wikiplugin_bigbluebutton`, `bigbluebutton_feature`

Parameters	Accepted Values	Description	Default	Since
<code>meetingid</code>	text	MeetingID for BigBlueButton. This is a 5 digit number, starting with a 7. Ex.: <code>77777</code> or <code>71111</code> .		5.0
<code>showattendees</code>	alpha	Enable or Disable the display of attendees list.	y	
<code>showrecording</code>	alpha	Enable or Disable the display of video recordings.	y	
<code>prefix</code>	text	Unregistered users will get this token prepended to their name.		5.0
<code>number</code>	text	The phone-in support number to join from traditional phones.		5.0
<code>logout</code>	url	URL to which the user will be redirected after logging out of BigBlueButton.		5.0
<code>voicebridge</code>	digits	Code to enter for phone attendees to join the room. Typically, the same 5 digits of the MeetingID.		5.0
<code>welcome</code>	text	A message to be provided when someone enters the room.		5.0
<code>recording</code>	0 1	The recording starts when the first person enters the room, and ends when the last person leaves. After a period of processing (which depends on the length of the meeting), the recording will be added to the list of all recordings for this room. Requires BBB >= 0.8.	0	5.0


**i** Tip

You should give both `tiki_p_bigbluebutton_join`, `tiki_p_bigbluebutton_create` and `tiki_p_bigbluebutton_view_recordings` permissions on the room (not globally). This is useful in case the BBB server is rebooted.
