

# Plugin Member Payment

*New in Tiki5*

Use this wiki plugin for users to make payments to extend the length of their membership to a group.

# Requirements

- The group must have a membership expiry  $> 0$  days
- Payment feature must be enabled and configured

# Parameters

Receive payment from a member to extend membership to a group

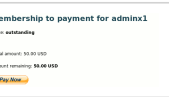

*The 365 days in the above example is set by the admin for the group as the number of days after which a user is automatically unassigned.*

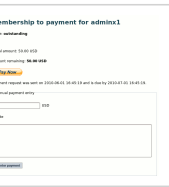
*Clicking on the continue button:*

Takes the user to a screen where the payment can be made. Here's an example with Paypal used as the payment method (set in the Payment admin panel):



*Manually completing payment information:*

An admin will be able to fill in the payment information in case of a 'manual' payment. Here's an example of what the admin would see for an unpaid payment:
