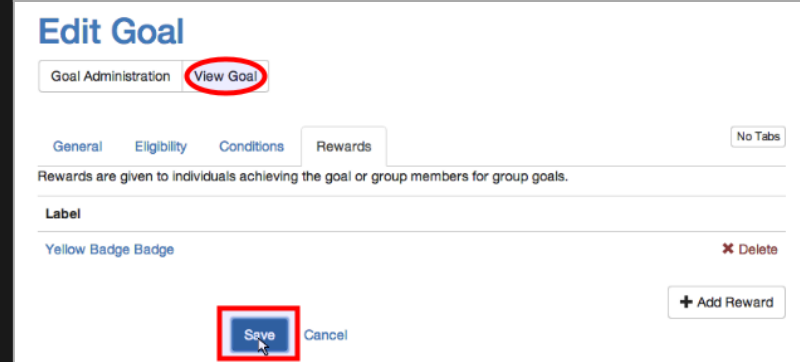
1.3. USE 'BADGES' AS REWARDS



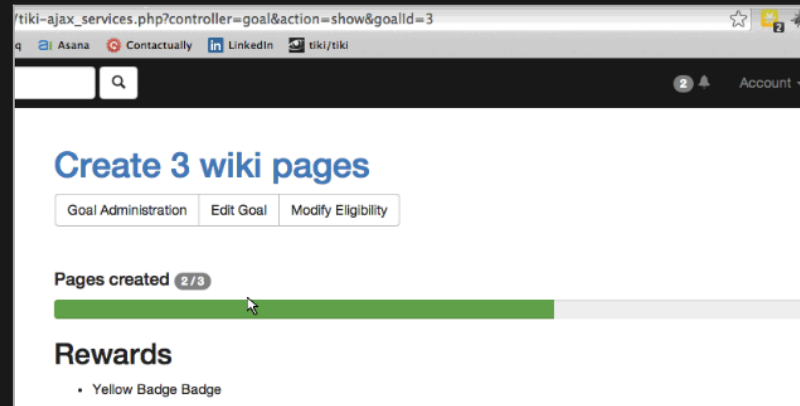

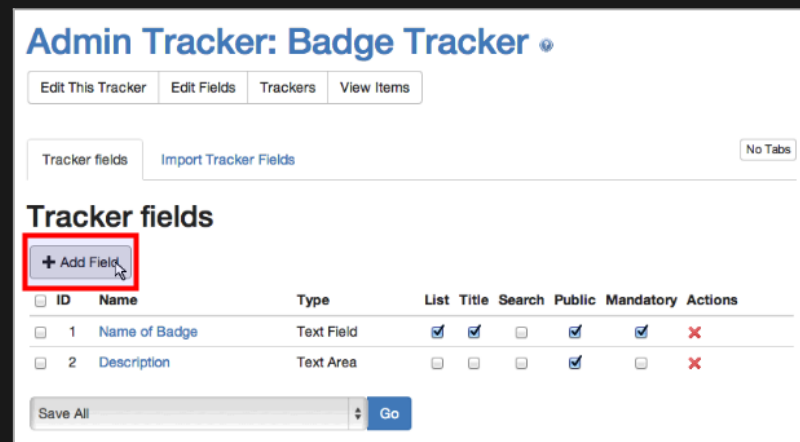

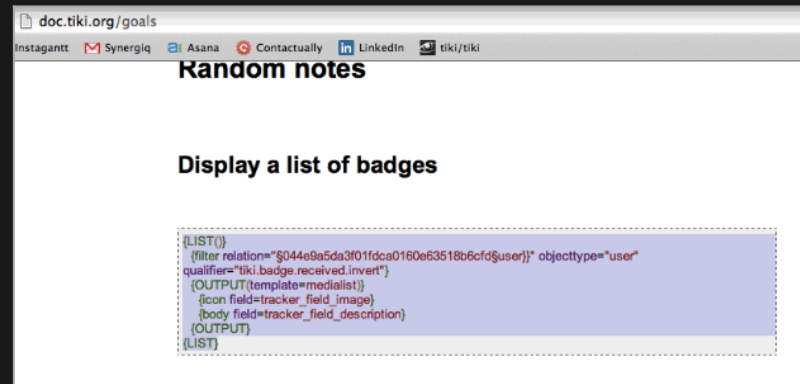

1.4. USE 'TIKI USER CREDITS' AS REWARDS

You can also change the reward type from using "badges", as shown above, to using "credits", which reuses the feature "[Tiki User Credits](#)", which allows you to define your own points and credit system in your own tiki site.
