Note: for Tiki versions prior to Tiki 6 use **\$jq** prefix instead of just **\$**.

Assuming that you have saved the files in `files/custom/jquery.easing.min.js` and `files/custom/jquery.lavalamp.min.js`, you have enabled jQuery and that you want to apply the LavaLamp "backout" effect on your top horizontal CSS menu the code above is all you should need, along with the CSS rules from `lavalamp_test.css` as required for the hover background image, etc. For more information about the The LavaLamp jQuery Plugin go to <http://nixbox.com/projects/jquery-lavalamp/demos.php> .
