## Reference attributes

**Biblio Code** A unique reference code per page. Used to link the in-page reference to the bibliography listing

**Author** The author(s) of the work

**Title** The title of the work

**Year** The year, season, etc. the work was created/published

**Part** Part of the work referenced, e.g. page numbers

**URI** A Link to the work

**Code** Code identifying the work, e.g. the ISBN number

**Style** Formatting style. See below for details

**Template** Formatting layout. Determines which fields to display, the ordering and more

## Macros available

~author~	Name of the author(s)
~title~	The title of the referenced work
~year~	Publication year, date, season, etc.
~part~	The part of the work referenced, e.g. pages 180-185
~uri~	URI to the referenced work
~code~	Code, e.g. ISBN, of the referenced work
~publisher~	The company or unit that published the work
~location~	The place, e.g. city, where the work was published
