Preferences required: `wikiplugin_perm`

Parameters	Accepted Values	Description	Default	Since
<code>(body of plugin)</code>		Wiki text to display if conditions are met. The body may contain <code>{ELSE}</code> . Text after the marker will be displayed to users not matching the conditions.		
<code>object</code>	text	Name or ID of the object to test if not global or the current object	21.3	
<code>type</code>	wordspace	Type of object referred to in Object ID	21.3	
<code>notperms</code>	<code>text</code> <code>separator: </code>	Pipe-separated list of permissions, any of which will cause the default text not to show. Example: <code>tiki_p_rename tiki_p_edit</code>	5.0	
<code>global</code>	<code>(blank)</code> 1 0	Indicate whether the permissions are global or local to the object	5.0	
<code>perms</code>	text <code>separator: </code>	Pipe-separated list of permissions, one of which is needed to view the default text. Example: <code>tiki_p_rename tiki_p_edit</code>	5.0	

Security

- Be careful not to use this plugin to display secure information if the user can see the source
- Local permissions may not work depending on the place or object the syntax is inserted (ex: works for `tiki-index_raw.php` but not for `tiki-editpage.php`)

Examples

Basic syntax

```
{PERM(perms="tiki_p_view|tiki_p_edit" notperms="tiki_p_rename")}{some content}{ELSE}{other content}{PERM}
```
