Browser title	Visible label in the browser's title bar on all pages. Also appears in search engine results.	
Fallback for tiki base URL	The full URL to the Tiki base URL including protocol, domain and path (example: <a href="https://example.com/tiki/">https://example.com/tiki/</a> ), used when the current URL can not be determined, example, when executing from the command line.	
Browser title position	Position of the browser title in the full browser bar relative to the current page's descriptor.
