## How to useÂ Share


### **Enable the Feature:**

Set it up in the Share admin panel:



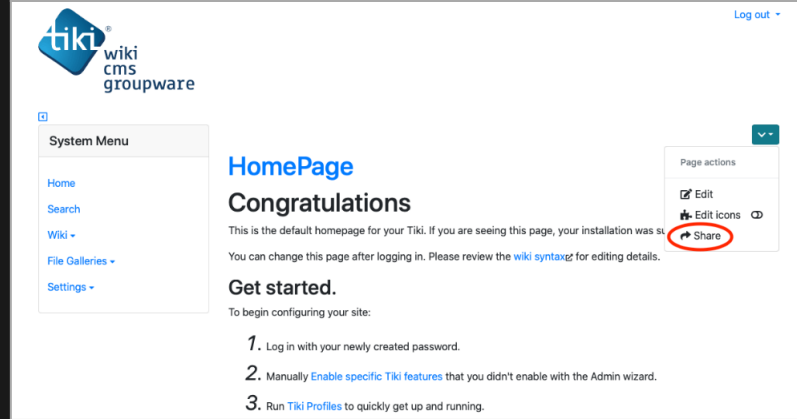
