No, but it is on the [Wiki-Syntax Images](#) doc page (thanks for the reply chibaguy)

It says:

Syntax	{img src= width= height= align= desc= link= }	
src=	The name and location of the image	Mandatory
width=	The width of the displayed image	Optional
height=	The height of the displayed image	Optional
align=	Alignment on the page - right, left, or center	Optional
imalign=	Alignment on the page - right, left, or center	Optional
desc=	A text description of the image	Optional
link=	A valid URL to make the image link to that URL	Optional
hspace=	adds a space, in pixels, on either side of the image	
alt=	Add alternative text. Must be encased in quotes.	Optional

Strange that **hspace** is neither Mandatory or Optional though...

Shame, it would be nice if it worked... (and if it had vspace too)
