## **Group and Category Permissions**

Can someone help? I am fairly new to tikiwiki, and I want to be able to let one Group view, comment and generally use the wiki. However, there are a few bits of the wiki that I want only certain groups to be able to edit. The best way to ensure this is to categorise the wiki pages, and to attach the edit permissions to the category rather than the pages themselves, as I only want the one group to be able to edit any current and future wiki page that is under a certain category. My problem is that I cannot figure out how to assign such edit permissions to the category. Any help?

Robin, category permission only apply for viewing so far. Edit permissions have to be set on a page by page basis.

You might want to have a look to the workspaces at Mod aulawiki: they can handle permissions more efficiently on groups of pages (within each workspace)


